

MAP OVERVIEW

This fully revised edition of our popular cycle map of the New Forest covers the whole of the New Forest area, from Fordingbridge down to Christchurch in the west and from Southampton down to Lepe Country Park in the east.

Printed at a large scale of 1: 40,000, and clearly drawn using OS data under licence, it includes a wealth of information for cyclists including:

- The entire network of cycle paths, bridleways and byways
- All Forestry Commission cycle marker posts
- National Cycle Route 2
- 12 suggested rides recommended by local cycle hire operators to suit all ages and abilities from families with young children to experienced cyclists including nine largely off-road rides and three all-road routes
- Car parks indicating those that are the most cycle-friendly – where it's easy to unload bikes and which lead straight onto the cycle tracks
- All main New Forest Tour bus stops for those wishing to use public transport
- Ferry routes
- Pubs, cafes and campsites
- Key sites, visitor attractions, viewpoints, picnic sites, nature reserves and beaches
- Inset town plans of Brockenhurst, Burley, Lyndhurst, Beaulieu and Lymington showing the recommended routes cyclists should take when heading out on a ride as well as other useful information like cycle hire shops, one-way streets and car parks
- The entire network of footpaths and other public rights of way including the long-distance Solent Way
